SPECIAL NOTES

- ⊙ The 2011 show will be publicized over local television and print advertisement prior to the show to maximize your experience.
- ⊙ Vendors provide their own display booths
- ⊙ Canopies will be allowed (must be anchored with sand bags) if they do not interfere with traffic
- ⊙ Vendors provide funds for change as there are no banking facilities in Moore, and the surrounding areas banks are not open on weekends.
- ⊙ Each vendor must complete Form ST-124, Idaho Sales Tax Declaration, Promoter-Sponsored Event. We will send the form with your acceptance notification. Each booth exhibitor will be responsible to report all sales tax to the Idaho State Tax Commission within 15 days after the Show. Idaho State sales tax is 6% and must be collected by the individual booth Exhibitor on all sales
- ⊙ Security will be provided after show hours. However, the King Mountain Car and Tractor Show and Moore and the City of Moore will not be responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items.
- ⊙ Booth set-up and Take-down: Booth setup begins on Friday at 4:00p.m. and should be complete by 7:30 Saturday Morning. Vehicles will be allowed in the area to unload and should be removed as soon as possible. Booth take-down will be allowed after 7 p.m. on Saturday.
- ⊙ Parking: Parking is free.
- ⊙ Electrical Power and Water: Electrical Power and Water are available, please advise us of your needs.
- ⊙ Food: Lost River Valley residents and/or organizations will have priority for food booths on a paid, first-come basis until April 1st. As food booths are limited we will not duplicate main item foods such as hot dogs, hamburgers, etc. Side items such as chips, etc. may be sold at any food booth. Once your booth has been accepted and your menu approved, NO changes will be allowed. Variety is beneficial to both vendors and patrons! Food vendors are required to supply a good-quality, heavy-duty electrical cord that will meet their amperage needs and a fire extinguisher. District 7 State Health Department requires licenses for food booths selling foods containing meat and/or milk products. Foods sold as a craft (vinegars, jellies, mixes, or mustards, etc.) should apply for a booth outside of the food booth area

We will try to accommodate any special needs you might have, however we need to be made aware of those needs by April 15, 2011.
